## Care & Cleaning Tips – Single Looped Hobble or Looped Hobble Sets



Below are warnings for use, and instructions about care and cleaning of your Shank's® Single Looped Hobbles and Looped Hobbles Sets ("Hobbles").

## Warning tag

The Hobbles have a warning tag. Be sure to read it before use.

- 1. Hobbles are only to be used for lifting horses or other large animals.
- 2. Hobbles should be visually inspected before each use.
- Hobbles can fail if damaged, misused or overloaded. Any Hobbles which appear damaged should be removed from service. See photos at the right, for examples of damage.
- 4. Observe rated load on warning tag. Do not use Hobbles if tag is removed or illegible.
- 5. Avoid sharp edges.
- 6. Do not expose to acid, aldehydes, ethers or bleaching agents (alkali). Remove Hobble from service if exposed.
- 7. Do not expose Hobbles to temperatures in excess of 194°F. Remove Hobble from service if exposed.
- 8. Avoid exposure to sunlight. Extended exposure of Hobbles to sunlight will degrade lifting capacity.
- 9. Death or injury can occur from improper use or care.

## Cleaning - Hobble ring

- The Ring can be washed with water, or with mild soap and water. A soft scrub brush can also be used.
- 2. The galvanized coating on the metal protects the ring from corrosion. Towel dry or allow the ring to fully dry before re-connecting it to the Hobble strap (if removable).

## Cleaning - Webbing strap(s)

- Hobbles can be cleaned with mild soap and water. Do <u>NOT</u> machine wash or machine dry. After cleaning, make sure that the Hobbles are allowed to dry properly before they are put into storage.
- 2. Avoid dirt, sand, metal chips and other abrasive materials. If they become

- embedded in the Hobbles, it will shorten the useful life.
- 3. Hobbles should be stored in dry area, off the floor
